Dear Mr. Byrne:The ARRB does not have the authority to prosecute anyone.We would be interested in knowing from where the false "report" came so that the erroneous information could be corrected. The documents being referred to are probably Secret Service records. The following excerpt from the ARRB report for FY 1995 stated the following:"In an apparent violation of the JFK Act, two boxes of Secret Service Protective Reports for President Kennedy in the 1961-1963 period that had been reviewed by the HSCA were destroyed. The destuction of these reports was authorized by the Secret Service after the passage of the JFK Act, and the records were destroyed at the Washington National Records Center in January 1995, shortly before the Board requested access to them. The Review Board is continuing its investigation of this matter." It is important to note that none of the reports that were destroyed relate to the Dallas trip.Thank you for writing.
