I got a voice-mail from Max Holland today indicating he wanted to ask me about Sen. Eastland. In your respective absences, I checked with Tom who thought it would be all right if I called him back. I did so and, in response to his questions, filled him in a little on what we have been doing, re: Senate Internal Security Subcommittee records. I told him a little about what I'd recently seen in the WC papers at NARA II (all open), and that there is an open finding aid to the closed Subcommittee record held at NARA I. He clearly hopes we will move expeditiously to secure permission to look at and eventually process the Senate records. Also: he says the Eastland Papers at the Univ. of Mississippi are closed, and he also says he thinks there are assassination records in them. As you'll recall, we've sent the Univ. of Miss. a letter (about a month ago). As far as I know, we have yet to hear back, but the fact that the collection there is closed suggests we should definitely follow up with them.
