Ron, could you review the records transmittal forms and identify all of the "DOJ leadership" records that we should verify have been searched to see if they contain assassination records? (Talk to me if you have questions about what offices are included in the "DOJ leadership" or if particular records are worth asking about.) Let's then prepare a letter (distinct from the big "compliance letter") addressed to Melanie Pustay that confirms the December 3 meeting AND identifies the records that we want to verify have been reviewed for potential responsiveness to the JFK Act. That way, come December 3, we may be able to start getting answers to our questions, rather than just the opportunity to ask them.
