The new chief of IRR (Elaine Rojick) called back yesterday to let us know that they concur with this idea, and that they'll promptly begin making copies for us. The principal advantage of this system is that we can use our contacts to try to get outstanding referrals cleared up -- then we can actually process the documents either for Board decision on any requested postponements or send to NARA.
