He inquired about a psychiatric profile of Oswald. He (Cultice) said that Larry Huff testified to the HSCA that 10-12 CID investigators authored a 20-page profile of Oswald after the assassination. He says the profile was based on interviews with people who knew Oswald in Atsugi. The report allegedly concludes that Oswald did not fit the profile of an assassin. He also said that the report was labeled "Marine Corps Eyes Only." According to Cultice, the HSCA was interested in pursuing this, but did not (could not) due to time constraints.
