He had not received it yet, but also admitted he had not gone to the post office recently, either. I explained its contents to him, and impressed upon him the need for him to sign and return the travel advance authorization immediately. I assume he will go to the post office today, and return the form to me ASAP. When I get it, I will pass it to you for David's signature and immediate processing. Although not overwhelmingly enthusiastic, he is still in agreement with coming to Washington on May 6th, and leaving on May 7th late in the day after the deposition is concluded. He seems to be proceeding under the assumption that it is his duty to come here, even if he doesn't particularly find the subject matter pleasant. Therefore, I feel it is now safe for us to go ahead and arrange air travel and hotel accomodation. AIRPLANE TICKETS and Hotel Reservation: I asked him what the nearest airport was, and he said Tulsa, Oklahoma. He would prefer NOT to leave early in the morning on May 6th--he would rather leave closer to mid-day, if possible. Please go ahead and arrange airline reservations (departing Tulsa mid-day on May 6th, enroute National; and departing National May 7th after 5:30 P.M., enroute Tulsa). If you arrange a Crystal City hotel, it will allow me to pick him up at the hotel on the way to Archives II on May 7th. My goal is to mail him his airplane tickets NLT Friday, April 25th. Mail service to Kelleyville, Oklahoma is not exactly at the speed of light.
