Riebe was the Navy medical corpsman who was enrolled in Navy civilian John Stringer's medical photography class at Bethesda who, because he had "the duty" that night, assisted John Stringer with photographic duties at JFK's autopsy. The extent to which he assisted, and the division of duties between Stringer and Riebe, is at issue, and unresolved. This is more than a minor matter, since the implications of their differing recollections involves key issues such as (1) how many, and which, photos taken at the autopsy are not now in the collection at NARA; and (2) the authenticity of certain autopsy photographs (specifically, the photos which show the back of the head intact).
