Specifically she wanted copies of documents or information on: (1) Robert Kennedy's personal papers which have been made public by the Review Board; (2) Documents regarding James Powell's activities immediately following the assassination; (3) The FBI program to monitor money sent by Marguerite Oswald to LHO while he was in the Soviet Union (I believe this was contained in the FBI appeals, which were dropped in late April), and (4) Though not related to the Holland article, any documents referred to by Judith Exner which she claimed prompted her to cooperate with the Vanity Fair article. Ms. Conway also requested a copy of Dr Hall's article in the Maryland Law Review. I suggested she might contact them for a copy. David has our only copy. I believe that several of these Review Board releases may have occurred before I came on board. I do not know if the specific FBI document referred to in (3) has been taken to NARA. Please send her what we have. Thanks, Thom
