When doing the final determination forms today, I came across a document that the HSCA put together for the Mexico City Trip #2 that listed, inter alia, the proposed interviews and pending items to ask the Mexican officials about. On this list they planned to request the files in the possession of the Mexicans regarding Duran, et. al and their detentions November 22, stenographic notes taken during each of these interrogations where they exist, and files in the possession of the Mexican officials regarding their investigation in Mexico of the Kennedy assassination. I think it would be worthwhile to talk to Ed Lopez or Hardway about this, and ask whether they followed up or not, what did the Mexicans have at that time especially any info. on the stenographic notes, and verify whether what the Mexicans provided was really all that there is. I read the pertinent parts of the Lopez report, but there was no indication that the Mexicans turned over anything that the HSCA hadn't already seen prior to the trip. I would like to call him next week.
