In the course of doing some other, related research, I located a memo that Fonzi wrote to Blakey regarding Antonio Veciana. In the memo, Fonzi talks about discovering an Army link to Alpha-66 which began in early 1960. Fonzi then recommends that the HSCA take a look at Army G-2 files for information on A-66 and Veciana. Remember that Fonzi, at last year's meeting here in DC, stated that he was handicapped from looking into the military intelligence connections with A-66 because of the Department of Defense's reluctance to hand over its files to the HSCA. In light of the fact that many of our research projects are repeats of things already looked into by the HSCA, I think it is important to state that the angle we are now pursuing on this issue is something which has not been examined before, and could potentially lead to some very interesting revelations.
