Date:07/09/97Subject:Johns Committee RecordsSummary of the Call:After being informed that I would be the staff analyst involved in the review of Johns Committee records at the Florida State Archives, I telephonically contacted Mr. Sam Burns of the Archives at 1500 on 08 Jul 97 to ask him several questions related to my visit. Mr. Burns informed me that the records of the Johns Committee are held at the Florida State Archives facility, located in the R.A. Gray Building in downtown Tallahassee. Mr. Burns stated that the Archives holds about three floors' worth of restricted records in the Gray Building, and that we would be reviewing the records in this restricted area. Mr. Burns was unable to cite an exact figure for the number of pages of Johns Committee documents currently held by the Archives, but that his best estimate was that there were 30 to 50 pages of files within each subject folder. He also gave me the phone number of the Florida State Legislative Library, where I was able to obtain a fax copy of the legislation which created the Johns Committee, and the law which protected certain types of information within the Committee's files. Furthermore, he made the following logistical points in reference to my trip:- The Gray Building is located within the state capitol complex, and it is within walking distance from the Capitol building;- Their hours of operation are 0800-1700 M-F, 0900-1500 Sat, closed Sundays;- He recommended renting a car, as cab service from the Tallahassee airport is somewhat scarce;- There are a number of hotels within walking distance of the Capitol. (He specifically recommended the Governor's Inn, although he did not indicate if the hotel offered government rates).
