Letter to the Archives Summary of the Call: 10:16 a.m. - Fogel returned my call. He said that he had not heard anything from the Archives. The Bureau will do the testing that we requested of the Archives and said that they can do it within their existing budget.
Fogel reiterated that senior DOJ officials were previously prepared to call the Archives to ask for the testing, but were dissuaded by DOJ staff who "threw cold water" on the idea of a high ranking DOJ official calling up and asking for the testing. As he has stated before, the staff position was that it was better for the ARRB to make the request because DOJ involvement would allegedly fuel conspiracy theories.
Fogel has shared our letter to NARA with his superiors, but he is not certain how high up the chain of command the letter has gone. He also shared a copy with the FBI lab people.
