Since we want to avoid making additional copies of these documents (ARRB currently retains only one highlighted copy of each document), I propose we follow this strategy:1. The established relationship we have with the FBI JFK task force will allow us to closely monitor FBI's review of the NSA docs. As such, we should not have to worry about the FBI needlessly holding on to these NSA docs for an extended period of time. I will walk these documents over to the FBI on Monday 3 November 1997.2. Since our relationship with DIA is far less established, we should provide copies of the documents to DIA. This ensures that ARRB retains copies in case DIA does not return them in time for either the November or December Board meetings.I can hand carry these documents to the Pentagon (where the Executive Secretariat offices reside) sometime early next week.END
