Dear Mr. Vignaroli:The Assassination Records Review Board is an independent federal agency created to oversee the identification and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The law gives the Review Board the mandate and the authority to identify, secure, and make available all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. About once every three weeks, the Review Board meets for a closed session, and the Board reviews still-classified documents and votes to release these records to the public. After the appropriate agencies are notified of the Board's decisions, and after administrative processing, the records are then transferred to the National Archives and Records Administration, where they are housed in the JFK Assassination Records Collection. To date, the Board has released tens of thousands of documents related to the assassination of President Kennedy that previously have not been available to the public. The Board has until September 30, 1998 to complete this mandate.
