The Assassination Records Review Board is an independent federal agency that was created to oversee the release of all documents related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, and to make these records available to the public at the National Archives and Records Administration. I can send you information about the Assassination Records Review Board, and about the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives. The Review Board was not established to draw conclusions about what happened in Dallas, TX on November 22, 1963, but to release the information to the public, so the public can make up their own minds.
