Subject: Re: Letter from ARRB Chairman Tunheim

Dear Mr. Austin: Thank you for your note in response to Chairman Tunheim's letter. You asked if additional information would be released. The answer is "yes". Just last month the Board released an additional 5,000 documents, and this month the number is about the same. Also, keep in mind that our release numbers compared to those of the FBI would naturally be different. Whether the Board exists or not, the agencies are still mandated to release their records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The agencies began transferring records to NARA before the Board was assembled. There has been cooperation with this effort. We have also established a compliance program wherein agencies must declare, under penalty of perjury, that they have made all efforts to locate all assassination records in their custody. With regard to the substance of the material that has been released, we cannot make judgments. We are here to release records. However, one cannot overlook the amount of information that is available now that had previously never been available. I think that is quite valuable. I hope I have addressed your questions and concerns. Thanks again for writing. Sincerely, Eileen Sullivan
