Date: 04/30/98Subject: Usher LogsSummary of the Call: I spoke with Claudia Anderson to get additional background on the usher logs. These were maintained by the Chief Usher and was a practice already in place at the White House, further indication that the JFKL should have received similar records. She sounded surprised when I told her JFKL did not have them. As the Chief Usher was a member of WH permanent staff, the individual working for the Kennedy White House most likely was the same individual in the Johnson White House. I jogged her memory with the name of J.B. West and that sounded right to her. She suggested we contact the White House historic office as well as the Usher staff for their records. She also noted that the logs for Johnson were kept in a bound daily planner book and believed they'd be in the same format for the Kennedy administration. Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
