He is willing to donate copies of the Fortas papers we identified provided that they are not opened until January 2000 (per the Fortas donor agreement). He was not willing to consider earlier public release. I told him we would send him a draft donor agreement providing for the records to be opened in 2000. I also advised Steve Tilley. My feeling is that we have little leverage to get these records open sooner so that it is in our interest to at least get copies in the hands of the National Archives and thereby assure that they will be opened in the JFK Collection in a year and a half.
