The Church Committee was headed by Senator Frank Church (who had Presidential aspirations) circa 1975-76. It was the "Senate Select Committee on Intelligence...blah, blah, blah." It investigated alleged (and actual) abuses of the U.S. intelligence agencies--included assassination plots against foreign leaders. Some of the allegations it investigated were allegations that the CIA, or rogue CIA agents, may have been involved in JFK's assassination. Its JFK assassination subcommittee was headed by Senators Hart and Schweiker, adn is skometimes referred to as the "Hart-Schweiker Subcommittee."The House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) was empaneled in the autumn of 1976, did most of its work in 1977 and 78 (except for report writing), and issued its report in the summer of 1979. It investigated both the JFK and MLK assassinations, but not the RFK.
