Names which feature prominently in the documents include: Bernard Barker, Richard Gibson, Felix Guin, Herbert Itkin, Joseph Merola, and Carlos Tepedino.The Board also voted to release 11 HSCA documents on anti-Castro activities, particularly the activities of the Movimento Democrata Cristiano, surveillance of the Russian and Cuban embassies in Mexico City, and issues related to the CIA's 1967 IG report on Castro assassination attempts. |
