If you persuade Steve Tilley you have a good reason, he might even let you see it.(2) Three bone fragments (from Kennedy's head) brought to the autopsy thenight of 11/22/63 Yes--missing.(3) The "Harper fragment" found the next day, and turned over to GeorgeBurkley a few days later. Yes--missing.(4) Another small fragment turned over to Burkley with the Harperfragment. This is the so-called "Weitzman" or "Burros" fragment--yes, it is missing also.I assume the two bullet fragments found in the front seat area of thelimousine are not lost. They, like CE 399, are in the JFK Collection at NARA.Thank you for any information you can give me.Sincerely,Milicent Cranor
