Schilling was contacted by staff member Doug Horne in regard to her possible association with, or knowledge of, the following assassination records: the Zapruder film, and the photographs and x-rays produced at President Kennedy's autopsy. The source of the leads received by the ARRB are two pieces of correspondence from one Joseph Scovitch, as listed below:-A handwritten letter dated 10-10-96, addressed from Mr. Scovitch to Dr. David Mantik, was passed in person to Dr. David Marwell, ARRB Executive Director, on November 15, 1966; and-A handwritten postcard dated 6-20-98 (apparently in the same handwriting as the above letter, naming some of the same "witnesses," or "participants" to purported film alteration events in 1963), signed by "J," and addressed to Professor J. Fetzer, was passed to Attorney General Janet Reno by a letter from James H. Fetzer (copy to the ARRB) dated July 5, 1998.
