Dear Mr. Ravnitzky: Thank you for your e-mail message dated August 2, 1998. I apologize for the delay in responding to you. We appreciate that you let us know that you received redacted copies of records relating to Dorothy Kilgallen. We suspect that the FBI placed files concerning Dorothy Kilgallen in its FOIA reading room several years ago, and at that time they were processed using FOIA, not JFK Act, standards. To the extent that these records deal with the assassination of President Kennedy, they may also have been processed by the FBI using JFK Act standards. You should, however, be aware that JFK Act-processed records are available through the JFK Collection at the National Archives and may not be available from the originating agency. We have requested that the FBI check on the status of its processing of assassination records that contain the name Dorothy Kilgallen. Sincerely, Eileen Sullivan
