I am currently employed as an analyst by the Assassination Records Review Board. The Board is a small, executive-branch agency created on October 26, 1992 by passage of Public Law 102-526, The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992.

In my current position as an analyst with the Assassination Records Review Board I act as a liaison agent between the Board and the CIA, as well as other federal agencies, for the purpose of negotiating information releases. This role requires that I not only successfully interpret and convey decisions made by the Review Board, but that I also convey the reactions and responses of the negotiating agencies back to my superiors and the members of the Board. Due to the sensitive nature of the information that I deal with, it is imperative that I be precise and exact in conveying observations, both from and back to the Board. A misstatement on my part could result in loss of goodwill and trust between our agencies, or a costly and acrimonious appeal of a Board decision. My ability to successfully perform these functions has prevented an such ill occurrence.
