Subject: Recommendation of Not Believed Relevant (NBR) Status for information
in Record Number 104-10088-10070

This record is a patchwork operations instructions for CIA employees on the subjects "COVERT APPROVALS AND RELATED MATTERS" and "RESTRICTION OF OPERATIONAL USE OF CERTAIN CATEGORIES OF INDIVIDUALS" assembled from clandestine services instructions of 1958 and 1963 and DDO instructions of 1973. In the 1993 review, CIA released all the information from the 1958 and 1963 instructions and a good percentage of that from 1973. In the current review, CIA is requesting to continue the postponement of information from the 1973 instructions.

The Review Board staff believes that the information of relevance to the assassination has been released in the 1958 and 1963 instructions and that the information from 1973 can be treated as NBR.

The staff recommends that the Review Board postpone the highlighted information as not believed relevant and recommends the substitute language: "details of CIA operations not believed relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy."
