Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, the Assassination Records Review Board requests that the Central Intelligence Agency provide access to any and all 201 files, personnel files, Office of Security files, P-files, or any other records relating to Gerald Patrick Hemming.

This request should be interpreted in its broadest reasonable sense. To the extent that you question whether a particular file or record is encompassed by our request, please let us know and we can advise you whether we seek to include it.

Should this request impose an unreasonable burden on you that we may not have anticipated, please advise us so that we can work with you to modify or amend the request accordingly.

In requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them "assassination records" and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.
