Subject: Additional Request Number 50, Harry Dean.

Harry Dean claimed to be an FBI informant on Fair Play for Cuba and to have information on President Kennedy's assassination. The Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) requested the Historical Records Review Board (HERU) provide Headquarters, Los Angeles, and Chicago files referencing Harry Dean. ARRB should continue to request several Headquarter files not yet provided by the Historical and Executive review Unit (HERU) to ARRB staff. The Chicago field office files referencing Harry Dean should be reviewed by ARRB staff when provided by HERU. Several Headquarter files maintained on microfilm were not reviewed because it was not believed that they contained information on Harry Dean. HERU and ARRB staff agreed that the files maintained on microfilm fall before the date scope requested and the classification codes of these files indicate criminal cases rather than the classification codes for the subjects Dean reported on.
