

Questions About Lee Harvey Oswald for IRS from ARRB Staff (As of June 10, 1998)

1. Were the employers listed ever given more than one EIN? If so, when, and what was that number? If so, is there an explanation?
2. Can the EINs on the chart be verified?
3. Please see footnote number 1 in the data chart; can the IRS verify that the same EIN was transferred from Hegewisch Corporation to Gerald F. Tujague, Inc.?
4. Can the “date business acquired (*i.e.*, date EIN assigned)” be verified where given on the chart?
5. Can the “date business acquired (*i.e.*, date EIN assigned)” be established where unknown?
6. Can the IRS comment on the accuracy of the official positions taken in the two letters from the Memphis office¹ regarding Lee Harvey Oswald employer identification numbers (*i.e.*, creation dates for the EINs)? Restated, which information as to the **creation dates** for the EINs for the 1955-1956 employers is correct...the dates in our data chart, or the dates provided by the Memphis office?

¹Both dated Oct. 17, 1995 (attached). One pertains to creation date for the EIN for the Dolly Shoe Company (72-0464241); the other pertains to the creation date for the EIN for the Pfisterer Dental Lab Company. Each IRS letter claims that based on examination of other numbers, the two in question were established in January, 1964.
