

The Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) has nearly completed its work on the CIA's core assassination records -- Oswald 201 File. The ARRB turns its attention now to the series of records that the CIA made available to the House Select Committee on Assassinations. These records range from those of direct relevance to assassination to others for which the ARRB is unable to identify any relevance.

This collection presents particular challenges to the ARRB because of its size and because of concerns about its relevance to the assassination.
