

Since the agencies have not completed their respective reviews, it is impossible to provide a confident estimate of the total universe of records that will require Board review. The ARRB is currently tracking approximately 24,000 records that contain postponements, but that number will undoubtedly increase dramatically. Since the vast majority of postponements fall into defined categories, decisions early in the review will apply to records that come later in the process. We are confident that the early decisions of the Board, which have consumed a great deal of time and resources, have provided a firm basis for a greatly accelerated pace in the future.
