Thank you again for taking the time to meet with me yesterday and for offering your thoughts and suggestions about sources of records pertaining to President Kennedy's assassination that may exist in New Orleans, and beyond.

I also appreciate your offer to find your Lee Harvey Oswald/David Ferrie/New Orleans file, which I understand from you has photographs relevant to the inquiry Congress mandated the Board to perform. I would also like to take you up on your offer to show me this file when you locate it. As I mentioned yesterday, the Review Board would potentially be interested in copies of any photos or documents your file contains. As I explained yesterday, all assassination records located by the Review Board will be placed at the National Archives in the John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection. For your information and better understanding I've enclosed a Congressional Research Service article about the legislation which created the Review Board and the Board itself. I've also enclosed a copy of the Anthony Summers article from "Vanity Fair" magazine which we spoke about. Both are excellent sources of information.
