ARRB Review Guidelines

1. The Board will, except in cases of great sensitivity, release all stations that the CIA has indicated it will not contest.
2. Of those stations that CIA will contest, the Board will release only those essential to documents that in turn will broaden and enrich the historical record of the assassination. Despite CIA objections, the Board will release stations for Eastern Europe, unless additional evidence of sensitivity is provided.
3. Those stations whose postponements are sustained will be identified by region and number according to a standardized list developed by ARRB staff (ie.: Western European nation #1, etc.)
4. For all but the most sensitive of remaining crypts, the digraph will be protected, the remainder of the crypt released, and substitute language provided. The most sensitive crypts will be postponed in their entirety, and substitute language will be used.
