Talking Points

1. We are here seeking State's input in the process.
 - a. Now (documents immediately at issue).
 - b. We want to make sure State's position is being conveyed accurately
(show examples)
 - c. In the future
(possibility of making presentations to the Board, etc.)

2. We want to make sure State has all information about:
 - a. The records currently at issue
(most of this information has already been disclosed)

 - b. Its role under the Act
Congress wants State to obtain foreign consent
This is an unusual case--assassination of President
Historically significant documents

Present clear and convincing evidence in support of redactions
