Dear Executor:

It was with great regret that we learned of the passing of Mr. Richard Nagell. Only a few days ago, on October 31, we had sent a letter to him in order to begin what we hoped would be a fruitful discussion about his records and knowledge of events related to the assassination of President Kennedy.

We understand that you were a relative and confidant of Mr. Nagell. We thus extend to you our sympathy for your loss.

As you may know, the Assassination Records Review Board is charged with the responsibility of collecting records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. As you are no doubt aware, Mr. Dick Russell has written book suggesting that Mr. Nagell may have been in possession of valuable information related to the assassination. In order to protect the interest of the American people in Mr. Nagell's records, we are enclosing a subpoena form to help clarify the types of records in which we are interested. We very much regret the necessity of sending such materials to you at this time, but we need to ensure that the records are protected.

We will be very pleased to work with you to reach a mutually agreeable time and place for examination of the records. Please contact us as soon as you conveniently can.
