I am hoping that by the time you receive this letter that Barry Harrelson, you, and I will have confirmed a date for a visit to the JFK Library early in March. During that visit, in addition to pursuing an approach to declassification of National Security records, I would like to spend some time reviewing the donor collections that I identified in my December 4 letter to you.

I would also like to follow-up on a discussion that we had regarding the Department of Justice microfilms. We have identified approximately two dozen microfilm rolls that we would now like to examine. (I am attaching a list identifying the numbers.) As you and I discussed earlier, the Review Board would very much appreciate it if you could arrange to send the films to the Archives in D.C. so that we could review them here. We are ready to review them as soon as they arrive.
