

CIA request for additional records and information CIA-?

As a part of our examination of the documentary record surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy, we would like to conduct a systematic review of cable and dispatch traffic between the CIA's Mexico City station, CIA headquarters, and JMWAVE during the period immediately surrounding Lee Harvey Oswald's visit to Mexico City and the assassination of President Kennedy. It is our understanding that although many of the cables and dispatches are in the Oswald and JFK files, not all cables and dispatches are included.

We hereby formally request the CIA to assemble all of cable traffic and dispatches between: (a) its Mexico City station and headquarters, and (b) its Mexico City station and JMWAVE during the period September 26, 1963 through December 30, 1963.

Because it may be appropriate in the future for us to examine all similar traffic between CIA headquarters and JMWAVE during this period, would you please provide us with your best reasonable estimate of the amount of time and effort that would be entailed in assembling cables and dispatches between headquarters and JMWAVE for the period September 26 through December 30, 1963?
