RE: ARRB Additional Information Request No. CIA-2

Dear John:

With our review of CIA records now underway, we find that several additional CIA records would be helpful in carrying out the ARRB's responsibilities under the JFK Act. We ask that you make available to the ARRB staff the following materials:

1. Mary McAuliffe's history of John McCone as Director of Central Intelligence;
2. Mary McAuliffe's history of the CIA entitled *A Secret World: An Unclassified History of the Central Intelligence Agency* (Oct. 1994);
3. Roberta Knapp's history of the CIA;
4. The transcript of Mary McAuliffe's interview of Sam Halpern, completed in the late 1980s and available in CIA History Staff files;
5. Lyman Kirkpatrick's investigation and report on the Bay of Pigs;
6. Copies of CIA telephone directories for the years 1958-1969, as well as a current CIA telephone directory;
7. The complete CIA document known as the "Family Jewels" (created during the tenures of Mr. Schlesinger and Mr. Colby);

8. Cleveland Cram's study entitled *History of the Counterintelligence Staff* (all volumes);
9. A bibliography of all CIA histories or analyses (including all memoranda, publications, and articles) prepared either by the history staff, the Inspector General and staff, or the General Counsel and staff that include *any* discussion of the Kennedy assassination, CIA counterintelligence during the years 1958-69, the Office of Security during the years 1958-69, Task Force W, the Special Affairs Staff, Operation Mongoose, the Soviet Russia Division (of the DDP) during the years 1958-63, and any actions or programs related to Cuba between the years 1960 and 1964; and
10. All files and records from all directorates and offices relating to the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (including file number 100-300-11).

We will of course take all necessary precautions to protect these materials in full accord with their security classifications. We would very much appreciate your making these materials -- as well as those included in our first request -- available to us as soon as you are able to locate them.

Please do not hesitate to contact me, Jeremy Gunn, or Mary McAuliffe should any portion of this request require further clarification.
