I am especially interested in papers relating to the Communist Party of the U.S.A. in the 1958-1967 period. In particular, I would like to read the minutes of meetings, reports, and any other papers relating to foreign countries. I note that the NUC description lists finding aids as well as a microfilm edition of the Draper papers.

Would you please send me a photocopy of your finding aid that describes the microfilm? I will be happy to reimburse you for your costs. Also, are you willing to lend microfilm reels through inter-library loan at the Library of Congress?
