Subject: Visit to Archives II

1. I located the remaining 3 protective reports that the USSS wanted to postpone entirely. They are in the LBJ Library material at College Park, and they have been open there since 1993. These three reports have been open at the LBJ Library (Box 15) for years according to Steve Tilley. Agency file no. 006256. See USSS list of November 9, 1995, Secret Service #24.
2. I looked through Warren Commission documents about Thomas Vallee. They are open, and they contain personal information that would eliminate the USSS claim of privacy. Dave and David have confirmed that Vallee is dead. I was hoping to find a copy of the document the USSS wants to redact.
3. I located a number of regular reports on Thomas Vallee at Archives I. (I have placed several of these quarterly reports in the SCIF.)
 - A. These documents are in limbo: they are not open at Archives II; the USSS has not returned them to Archives I; the USSS has not delivered them to ARRB to review.
 - B. The information in these documents duplicates the portions the USSS wishes to redact in agency file no. 008581.
4. The LBJ Library material (Box 15) contains several specific reports about USSS protective measures and documents pertaining to the Dillon Commission. This will be useful for comparing the Secret Service liaison file material.
5. The protective survey for JFK's Milford, PA trip is not in the file folder at Archives II. There are withdrawal forms for the entire trip report at Archives II.
6. Still need to confirm that letter from USSS Miami (with names) is open. Kris said it was not referred to anyone. Steve said if Kris wants to open it, Steve will open it.
