Subject: Records of the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee (SISS, aka the Eastland Committee) of the Senate Judiciary Committee

Brian Rosen and I reviewed the records identified by Joe Freeman and listed in his memo to you of September 13, 1996 (*see* Freeman to Gunn, attached) to determine whether there were assassination records in the records of the Eastland Committee. We identified thirteen transcripts of executive session testimony before the Eastland Committee that we believed should be processed by NARA's Center for Legislative Archives as assassination records. NARA processed these records under the JFK Act and has released all thirteen transcripts in full to the JFK Collection. They also sent three boxes of press clippings regarding Lee Harvey Oswald and the assassination investigation to the collection without RIFS, inasmuch as these records have been open and available to researchers for many years. Attached also is NARA's final memo regarding their processing of these records, as well as RIFs for the thirteen transcripts.
