re: Hearings on the Destruction of J. Edgar Hoover's files and FBI recordkeeping

There are some sections which may be of interest, which I did not copy. Especially the list of classifications used in the basic filing system referred to on page 130. Also perhaps the interview between committee staff member Robert Fink and former Assistant Director William C. Sullivan.

Of particular interest is the opinion of the Justice Department regarding the FBI system of records. I guess there were various interpretations of the FOIA/PA among the agencies. Also the July 19, 1966 and January 5, 1967 memoranda regarding "black bag" jobs are of special interest.

I also found the hearings on the destruction of the Oswald note, but it is seven pieces of microfilm long, and I did not have time to get into it deeply. We can discuss where to go on this matter.
