 - 7/26/95 meeting with main Treasury
 - As of 7/26/95, they had not started to search for records
 - I talked to Steve Tilley on 8/17/95 and confirmed that he has received nothing from Customs
 - Documents requested from Customs
 1. FRC - more detailed listing
 2. document retention and destruction policies and agreements with NARA, esp. in the late 60s.
 3. description of filing system
 4. organizational chart from late 50s to the present
 5. book, History of Customs that Brian London mentioned
 6. all documentation, including directions to staff, about searching for records under the Act
- Must search all parts of Customs, including HQ, field offices, and Federal Records Centers.
- Topics
 - liaison with various committees (WC, HSCA, Rockefeller, Pike, Church)
 - including documentation of any records that may have been destroyed in the FRCs.
 - HSCA requested info on at least 130 individuals and 2 WC exhibits
 - see attached "issues" sheet
- Status of Referrals
- ARRB access
 - have our security clearances arrived?
