Review Board's Suggestions (from 9/8/98) for Changes in Draft Report

(1) Re-ordering of chapters

- Chapter 2 (section by section analysis) will become an appendix
- Chapter 3 (start-up and definition of assassination record) will become chapter 2
 - Chapter 2 will further explain how the Review Board defined assassination record so that it could seek records that would enhance the historical understanding to the assassination, and not just records that mentioned the assassination.
- Chapter 8 (public activities) will become chapter 3
 - Introduction to chapter 3 will expand to state that one reason that prior investigations failed to instill public confidence was that they conducted their work in secret. The Review Board sought to set itself apart by conducting its work in the public eye.
- Chapter 9 (records from non-federal sources) will become chapter 8

(2) Include examples

- All chapters will include more textual.
- Some chapters will include document illustrations. For example, the section on CIA sluglines in Chapter 5 will include a photograph of a CIA document that contains a slugline. The illustration will identify the slugline as "slugline."

(3) Create glossary

- Report will include a glossary of most common terms of art and acronyms.
