Dear Mr. President:

On behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, I have the honor of enclosing herein a copy of "The Assassination Records Review Board Final Report." The Review Board has successfully completed its work as mandated by the *President John F. Kennedy Records Collection Act of 1992*, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994).

The Review Board has endeavored to obtain records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy and to release those records to the fullest extent possible. The Review Board members each contributed significant personal and professional time to this project. We have done so in the hope that our release of assassination records will shed new documentary light on the assassination of President Kennedy.

The Review Board's report is unanimous. It summarizes both the Review Board's work since 1994 and it also summarizes the Review Board's legacy -- the John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives and Records Administration.
