1. Put with the Angleton section under Records of Senior Officials:

Because the files that were once known as Angleton's have been dispersed within the DO records, they are no longer identifiable as a collection.

2. Put under the George Bush section for Names:

The Agency has made a thorough search of its records in an attempt to determine if an individual identified as "George Bush of the Central Intelligence Agency" in a certain FBI document dated November 1963 was George Herbert Walker Bush. That search determined the Agency has no record of any association with George Herbert Walker Bush during the 1963 time period.

3. Put under Harold Weisberg section of Warren Commission critics:

Weisberg, Harold -- An OSS "Service History" Form 1003a indicates subject worked for OSS from 15 January to 30 September 1945, first as a consultant and then as a research analyst. On the later date he was transferred to the State Department.
