

From an August 7, 1995, press release from the Coalition on Political Assassinations:

“Dan Alcorn, General Counsel of the Coalition [on Political Assassinations], stated, ‘All parties concerned should recognize the legal requirement of full disclosure under the JFK Records Act, and immediately release all these records to full public review. The seal of secrecy on the grand jury records has clearly already been broken. In addition, the ARRB should *prohibit* private access or physical possession of files defined as ‘assassination records’ until they make the files fully public.’”
