Re: ARRB Request for Additional Information and Records No CIA-10

Dear John:

Pursuant to the authority under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, the Assassination Records Review Board requests that the Central Intelligence Agency provide access to information on the following topics:

1. All files on Theodore Shackley (including, without limitation, personnel, 201, "P", and others) for the period in which he was first stationed at JMWAVE through October 1964;
2. All files on David Morales, for the period in which he was first stationed at JMWAVE through October 1964;
3. All files on Clay Shaw, including all records showing the disposition of his files and/or destruction records;
4. All files related to project.

This request should be interpreted in the broadest reasonable sense. To the extent that you question whether a particular type of file is encompassed by our request, please let us know so that we can discuss the breadth of the request.

Should any of these requests impose an unreasonable burden on you that we may not have anticipated, please advise us so that we can work with you to modify or amend the requests accordingly.

Moreover, in requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them “assassination records” and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.
