Dear Ms. Pustay:

As you know, the Review Board must complete its work under the JFK Act by September 1998. Accordingly, this will confirm our previous discussion in which the Review Board requested that:

1. the Department of Justice (Leadership Offices) submit to the Review Board, by July 1, 1998, all documents whose release the Department seeks to postpone in whole or part under the standards of the JFK Act;
2. the Department place all its assassination records in the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives by August 3, 1998; and
3. the Department submit to the Review Board, by August 3, 1998, its Final Declaration of Compliance under the JFK Act.
