Subject: JFK Autopsy Materials

I have two requests concerning the use of your conference room and access to the JFK autopsy materials:

1. We plan to conduct depositions with Drs. Boswell and Humes and believe that it is important to have access to the original autopsy photographs and x-rays during these depositions. The only practical arrangement would be for us to conduct the depositions at Archives II. We are currently planning the depositions for the mid-January to mid-February period.
2. In preparation for the depositions, we have requested the assistance of an expert consultant<sup>1</sup> to help us to interpret some of the autopsy materials. We anticipate that we would meet with him at Archives II in early to mid January.

Please let me know as soon as possible if we will be able to proceed as planned.
