YOU ARE HEREBY REQUIRED AND DIRECTED, PURSUANT TO 44 U.S.C. § 2107, TO APPEAR BEFORE:

T. Jeremy Gunn, General Counsel of the Assassination Records Review Board at 600 E Street, N.W., second floor, in the city of Washington, D.C., on the 25th day of April, 1996 at 10:00 a.m., or at such other time and place to which the parties shall mutually agree, to testify under oath regarding: the autopsy of President John F. Kennedy and any records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy.

YOU ARE HEREBY REQUIRED to bring with you, to produce and to make available for inspection and copying or reproduction at said time and place all books, records, correspondence, electronic recordings, photographs, motion pictures, and documents that are in your possession, custody, or control and which are described in Exhibit A attached hereto in accordance with the attached definitions and instructions.

The production of documentary material in response to this subpoena must be made under a sworn certificate, in the form set forth, by the person to whom this subpoena is directed or, if not a natural person, by a person or persons having knowledge of the facts and circumstances relating to such production.

YOU ARE HEREBY REQUIRED to bring all documents and records in your possession, custody, or control, including, without limitation, handwritten notes, memoranda, drawings, photographs, tape recordings, reontgenograms, motion pictures, and correspondence that relate to:

1. the autopsy of President John F. Kennedy;
2. any documentation of the chain of custody of records, artifacts, or evidence related to the autopsy of President John F. Kennedy;
3. any testimony or interviews conducted in conjunction with the Warren Commission, the House Select Committee on Assassinations, or any other official body of the United States that relate to the assassination or autopsy of President John F. Kennedy;
4. any interviews between you and any other person or persons that relate to the assassination or autopsy of President John F. Kennedy; and
5. any correspondence between you and any other person related to the autopsy or assassination of President John F. Kennedy.
